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### **GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACTS**

1. Abstract must be written in English.
2. Abstract to be submitted online at
3. Registration to the conference is **MANDATORY** for the presenting author.
4. Abstract must not exceed 200 words excluding the title and authors' name.
5. Abstracts must be in MS – word format, 11 point size, Calibri font on a single page.
6. Write clearly the title, the names of authors and the name of the institute.
7. Underline the name of the presenting author. Do not include degrees or designation.
8. Abstract should be structured to include Background, Aims, Methods, Results and
9. Conclusion.
10. Graphs, illustrations and diagrams are not permitted within the abstract.
11. Incomplete abstracts will not be accepted

### **GUIDELINES FOR POSTERS**

1. SIZE : 3 feet in width X 4 feet in length
2. A soft copy (PDF) of the poster also needs to be sent to **icamidconf2014@gmail.com**
3. Captions, title, authors and affiliation on top of the chart should be self-explanatory.
4. Each figure, table and graph should have a proper heading on top
5. Responsibility lies with the presenter to set up & remove their posters within the
6. Scheduled time and should ensure their presence during the display time.
